



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
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
	
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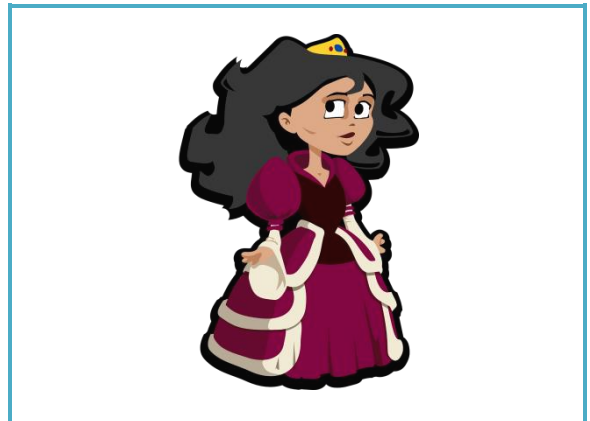
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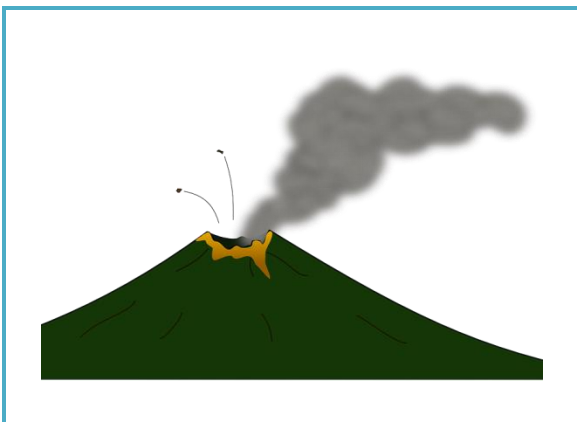
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



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
	
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
	
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
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
	
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
	
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
	
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
	
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Instructions

- Print out the following six initial sounds sheets.
- Ask children to look at the pictures and choose the correct initial sound to match the image, from the two given.
- Children should then mark the correct sound in some way e.g. circle it with a colour pencil, underline it or use a bingo 'dabber' to mark it.
- For a reusable resource, laminate the sheets and ask children to use dry wipe markers to mark the initial sounds.
- As an extension activity for higher attaining children, ask children to cut out the cards, stick them in their books or on a larger sheet and write the correct word underneath.
