

Teaching notes:

Activity 1:

Aim: To recognise the letter **x** amongst the range of words in the grid. Use the **x** phoneme sound to help read the relevant words.

- Children to colour or tick words that contain the letter **x**.

Activity 2:

Aim: To solve the anagrams – all words contain **x** phoneme

- Teacher can write the letter **x** into the grids beforehand for a simpler activity

Extension ideas:

- Handwriting practise – letter **x**
- Have a box and a range of objects/pictures, some with the letter **x** in their name. Children place any **x** items in the box e.g. toy fox, piece of flex, picture of a pixie, wax crayon etc.
- Look, Cover, Write, Check chosen **x** words for spelling purposes
- Put the given **x** words into sentences (verbal or written)
