## Teaching notes

Print and cut out the spinner, arrow and the cards and laminate them.

To make the spinner, push a butterfly clip / paper fastener through the middle of the arrow. Then push it through the middle of the circular spinner base. Bend back the clips and ensure that the arrow spins freely.

## You will need:

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- One spinner per group
- A set a laminated cards per group
- One follow-up worksheet per pupil

## Instructions

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- The first child spins the spinner, reads the word and tells their partner a sentence containing that word.
- If correct, they collect a picture card.
- The winner is the person who collects the most picture cards within the allotted time.
- Next, children could complete the follow-up written task.
