Learning Objectives:

- To learn an alternative pronunciation for the trigraph 'ear'.
- To blend together sounds to read 'ear' words.

You will need:

- A partner
- Two tree sheets
- A dice
- Two green crayons

Getting started

- Although ear is a phase 3 phoneme/grapheme this lesson is a phase 5 lesson based on an alternative pronunciation of ear.
- Carefully look at the pears on the tree. Write in the missing 'ear' sound to finish each of the words.
- Read each of the 'ear' words.
- With a partner, take turns to roll the dice and count the number of spots.
- Find the correct number of 'ear' words to match with the number on the dice.
- Colour the pears in a green colour.
- The winner is the person who colours in all of the 'ear' sound pears first.
