









Teaching notes

Instructions for game one – for three people

Print, cut out and laminate the pizza slices and toppings. Provide some fish slice kitchen utensils. Place all the toppings face down on the table. Ask children to take a slice of pizza each. They then take it in turn to use the fish slice to flip a topping over. If it matches a word on their pizza they keep it, if not they should put it back. The winner is the first to find all their toppings.

Instructions for game two – for two people

Print, cut out and laminate the whole pizza template and toppings. Place all the toppings face down on the table. Working in pairs, the first child chooses a topping, turns it over and reads out the word. Their partner must write the word on their pizza template (e.g. they could draw the topping and write the word inside it). The first child then checks the spelling using the topping card and then puts that topping card to the side. Children then swap roles and continue until their pizza is full.
